

**WINDOW COFFEE TABLE**  
**EYES FOR THE JOB- EPISODE 308.1**  
**'RECLAIM TO FAME'**



**MATERIALS NEEDED**

Window  
Sixteen pieces of 1"x12"  
Custom-fitted Acrylic Glass  
Rubber Bumpers  
One sheet of Plywood, 3/4" x 4' x 8', G1S  
One Hinge  
One decorative handle  
100 Screws 1 1/2"  
Panhead Screws  
4 Castors  
Lid Stay  
Paint

## **TOOLS NEEDED**

Router Table  
Chop Saw  
Brad nailer  
Drill  
Glue  
Clamps  
Paintbrushes



## **STEP BY STEP BUILD PLAN**

1. Source a Wooden antique-style window.
2. Using a mitre saw, cut two 1"x 12" at 49 1/4" inches and two 1"x 12" at 19 13/16 inches.
3. Rebate the bottom of the 49 1/4" pieces 1/4" x 5/8" stopping 3/4" from each end. rebate the 20" pieces 1/4" x 5/8" the whole length
4. Make a box by screwing or nailing 1"x 12"s together with the 49 inches as the outside and 21 inches as the inside.
5. Using a table saw, rip plywood to 48"x 20 9/16" inches. Then glue and nail it into the rebate in the bottom of the 1"x 12" doc box with 1.25 inch nails.
6. Attach four casters using panhead screws.
7. Attach the window to the top of the box using hinges at 1.5 inch screws. Attach a lid stay at each end to prevent slamming on fingers.

8. Attach handle to the opposite side of the windows from hinges using 1.5 inch screws.
9. Finished as desired, distressed paint, modern paint, etc.
10. Attach tempered glass to top of table using rubber grommets and screws
